Mark your calendar now for Canada's Largest One Day Cheerleading Competition on Saturday, May 15, 2004, at Paramount Canada's Wonderland, on stage, at Kingswood Music Theatre.

- For the category order, visit www.powercheerleading.com two
  weeks prior to the event. Each team will be listed in their respective
  category two weeks prior to the competition. Please note that there
  will be no changes permitted with the team order or category order
  for any reason. Your team will compete in your assigned category,
  in the assigned time-period. This event will follow PCA Competition
  standards PCA ALL MUSIC format.
- Teams are NOT required to include a cheer in their routines. Teams that cheer will not be penalized, but will only have it scored as part of the over-all category.

- Teams are responsible for providing their own music and a person to start and stop the CD or audio tape.
- Music must be provided in CD or cassette form.
- When using CD format for music, please don't use re-writable CDs.
- Timing starts at the first obvious start of music, movement or cheering and stops upon the obvious completion. <u>Entry and exit are</u> not considered.
- Routines exceeding the time limit will receive a 3 point deduction.
- The competition floor is 54' x 42' and is covered with gym mats.
- There is no penalty for stepping off the matted area.

#### **Choose From 11 Divisions**

SCHOOL TEAMS All members must be from the same school.

- 1. Youth / Primary: grades 6 and under, girls and boys
- 2. Junior: grades 8 and under, girls and boys
- 3. High School Intermediate: may include 1 male
- 4. High School Advanced: may include 1 male
- 5. High School Small Co-ed: may include 4 or less males
- 6. High School Large Co-ed: may include 5 or more males

#### **ALL-STAR TEAMS**

- 1. Youth/Primary All-Star: grades 6 and under
- 2. Junior All-Star: grades 8 and under
- 3. Senior Intermediate All-Star: may include 1 male
- 4. Senior Advance All-Star: may include 1 male
- 5. Co-ed All-Star: 2 or more males

\* NOTE: PCA and PCW reserve the option to add or delete divisions (ie. Junior or Primary "Club", if there are sufficient teams to justify it). Teams of this nature are encouraged to report early, their intent to compete such that we can prepare a division accordingly. If 2 or less teams register, they will be moved into the appropriate age/grade, class/school division.
